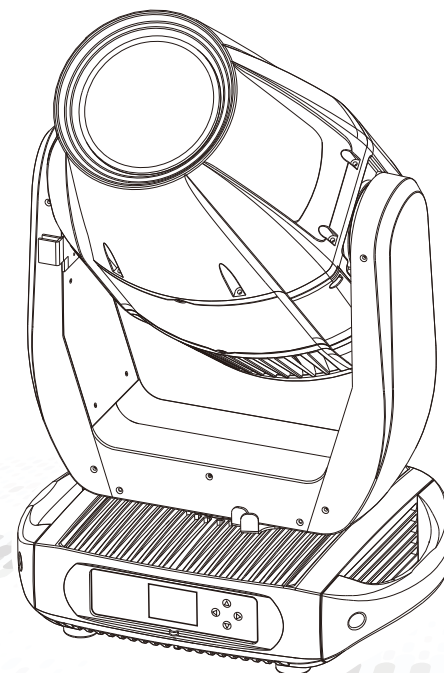

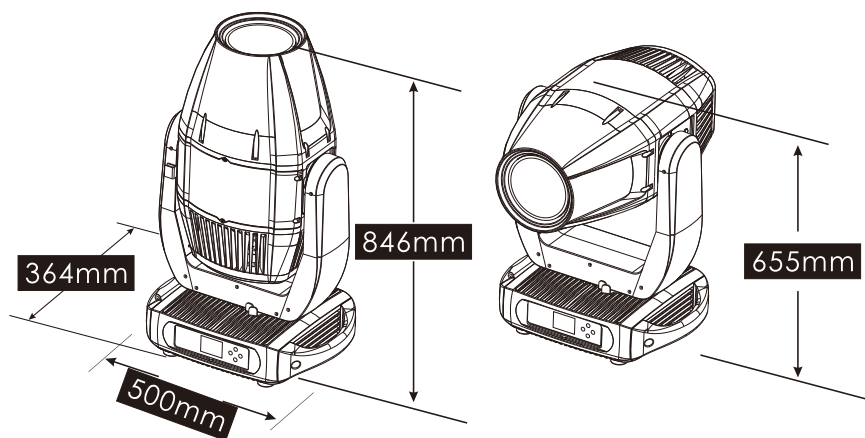

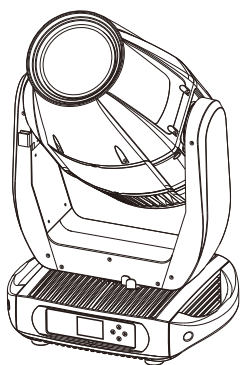

2 INSTALLATION

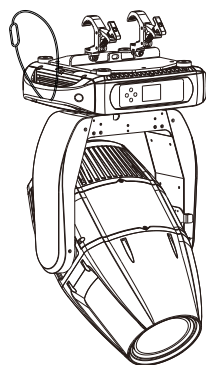
2.1 Mounting

Always use a safety cable when mounting the fixture in any elevated position.



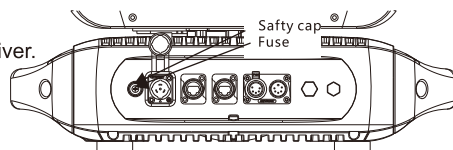

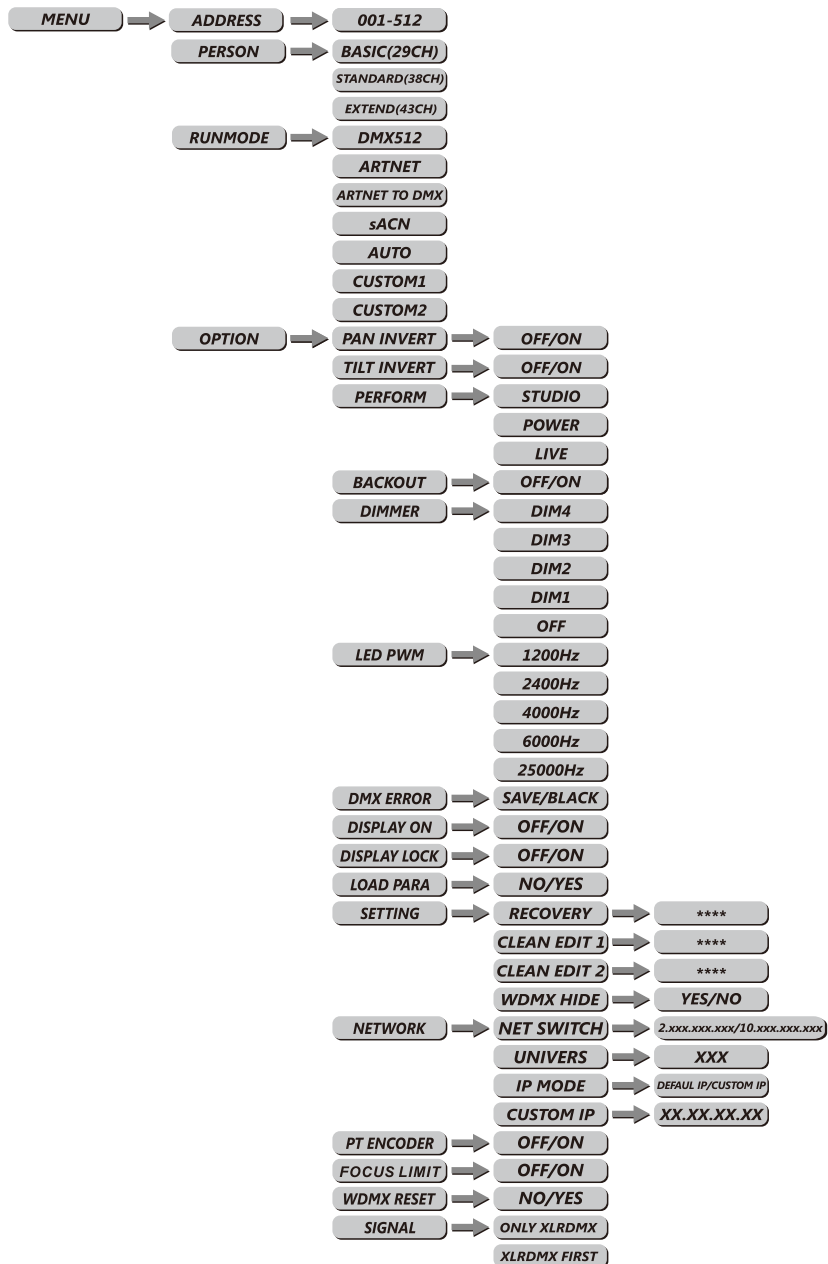

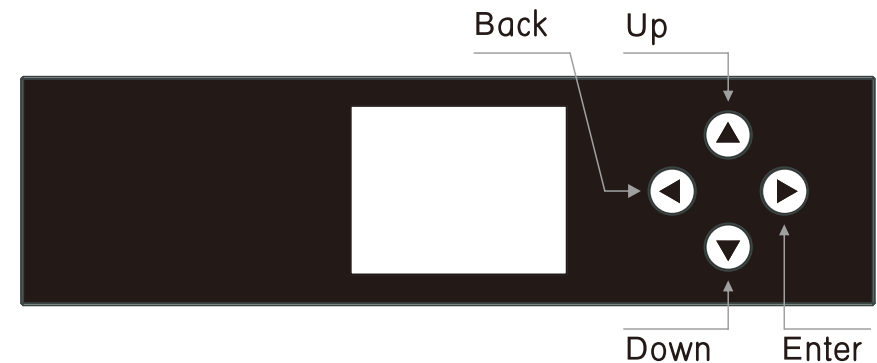
2.3 Power Connections

If the signal cable is over 60m between the DMX512 controller and fixture or between two fixtures, then a DMX signal amplifier is needed as well.

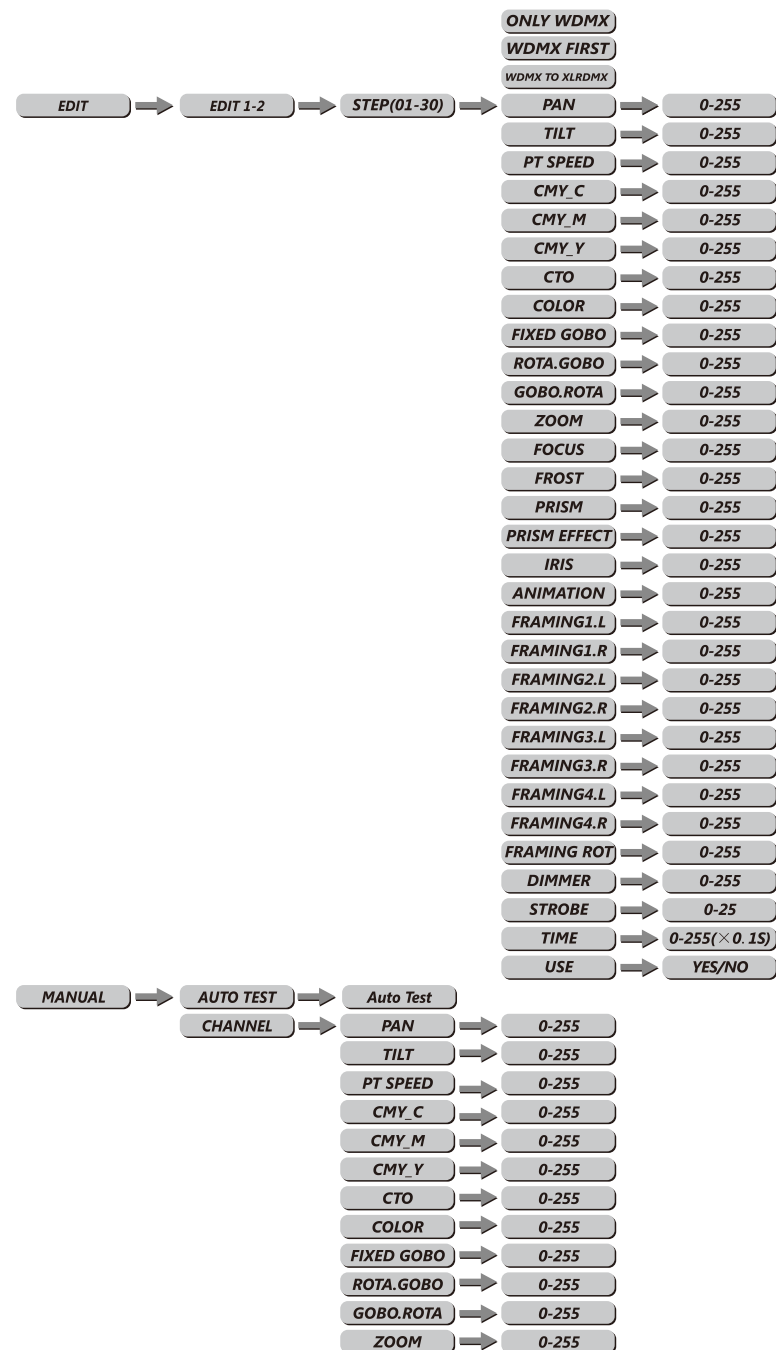
3 DISPLAY PANEL OPERATION

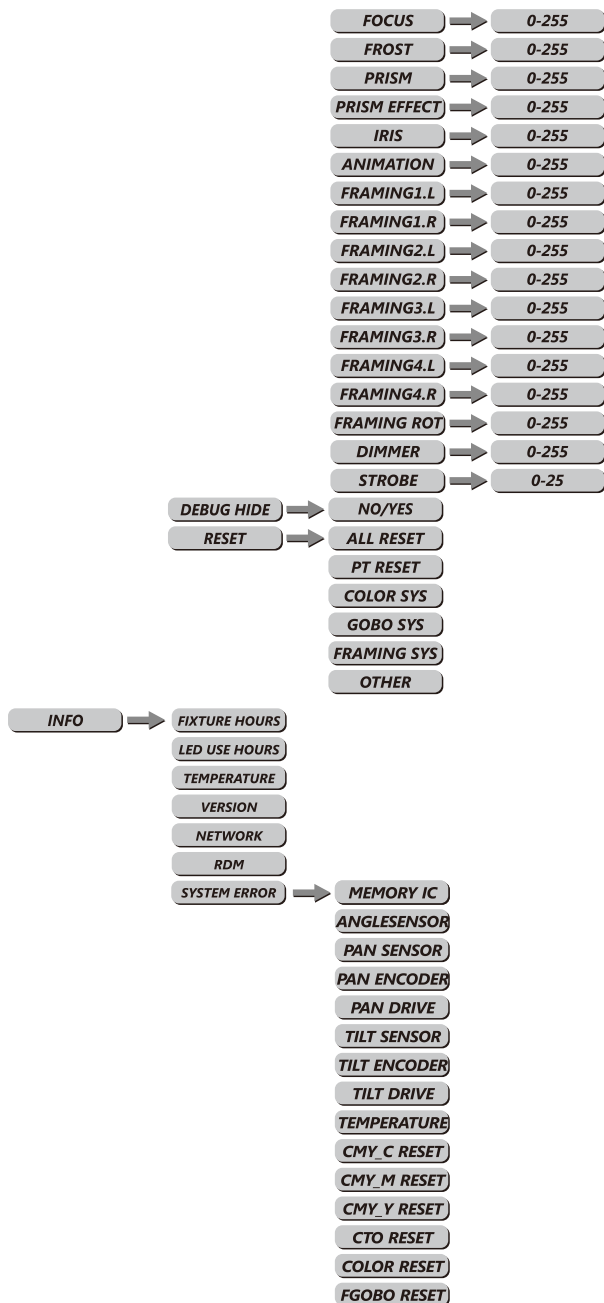
3.1 Display Operation



- Up: Scroll 'UP' through the menu list or increase the value of the current function.
- Down: Scroll 'DOWN' through the menu list or decrease the value of the current function.
- Left(Back): Scroll through the main menu.
- Right(Enter): Enter the currently selected menu or confirm the current function value.
- When the display locked, please unlock the display as below:
 1. Keep pressing BACK around 5sec, until the display shows inset password,
 2. Press “up down up down, enter” to unlock.

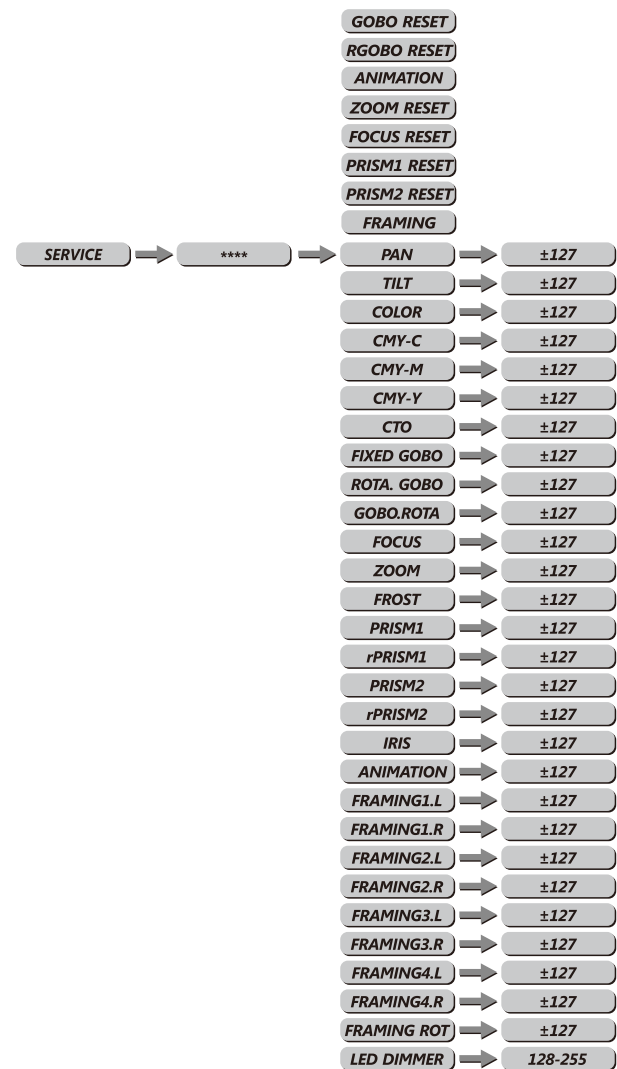

3.3 Dmx Address



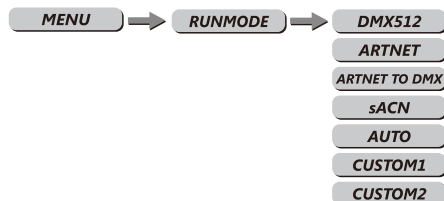
- enter the DMX mode to set the dmx address.

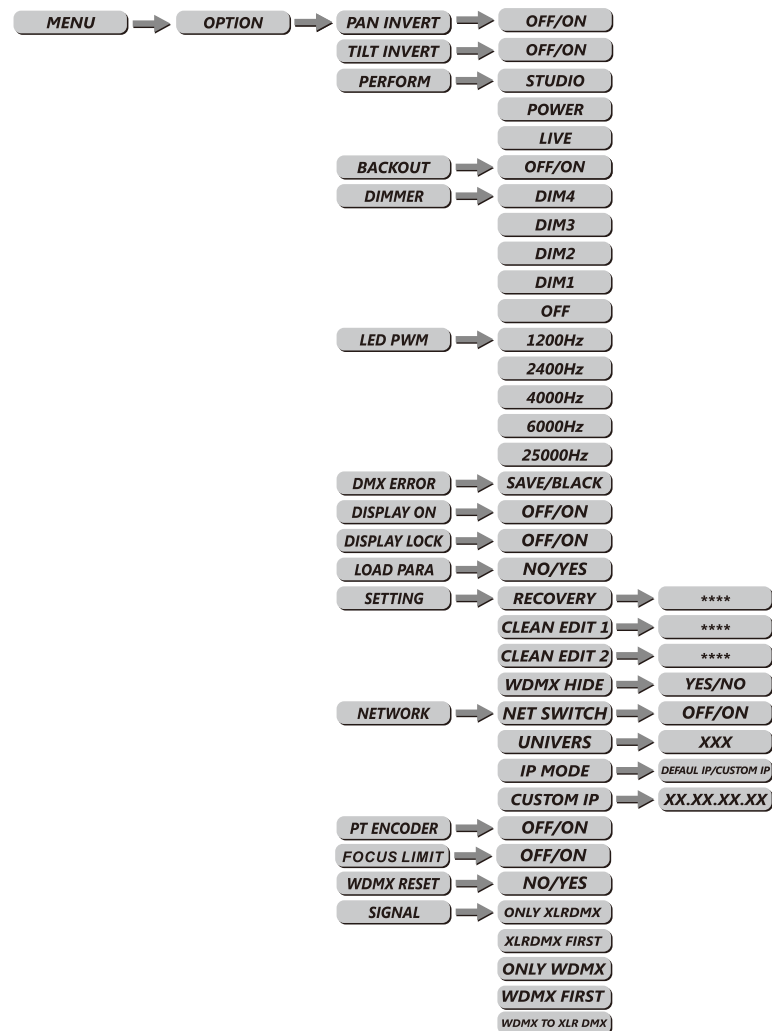

- **PAN** : Pan position fine adjustment Push up and down buttons adjust ± 127 value.
- **TILT** : Tilt position fine adjustment Push up and down buttons adjust ± 127 value.
- **COLOR** : Color position fine adjustment Push up and down buttons adjust ± 127 value.
- **CMY-C** : CMY-C position fine adjustment Push up and down buttons adjust ± 127 value.
- **CMY-M** : CMY-M position fine adjustment Push up and down buttons adjust ± 127 value.
- **CMY-Y** : CMY-Y position fine adjustment Push up and down buttons adjust ± 127 value.
- **CTO** : CMY-Y position fine adjustment Push up and down buttons adjust ± 127 value.
- **FIXED GOBO** : Fix gobo position fine adjustment Push up and down buttons adjust ± 127 value.
- **ROTA. GOBO** : Rotation gobo position fine adjustment Push up and down buttons adjust ± 127 value.
- **GOBO.ROTA** : Gobo self-rotation position fine adjustment Push up and down buttons adjust ± 127 value.
- **FOCUS** : Focus position fine adjustment Push up and down buttons adjust ± 127 value.

- **FRAMING ROT** : Fine adjustment of cutting component position, adjusting the ± 127 value with the up and down keys.
- **LED DIMMER** : LED maximum brightness limit, adjust the value of 128~255 by the up and down keys.

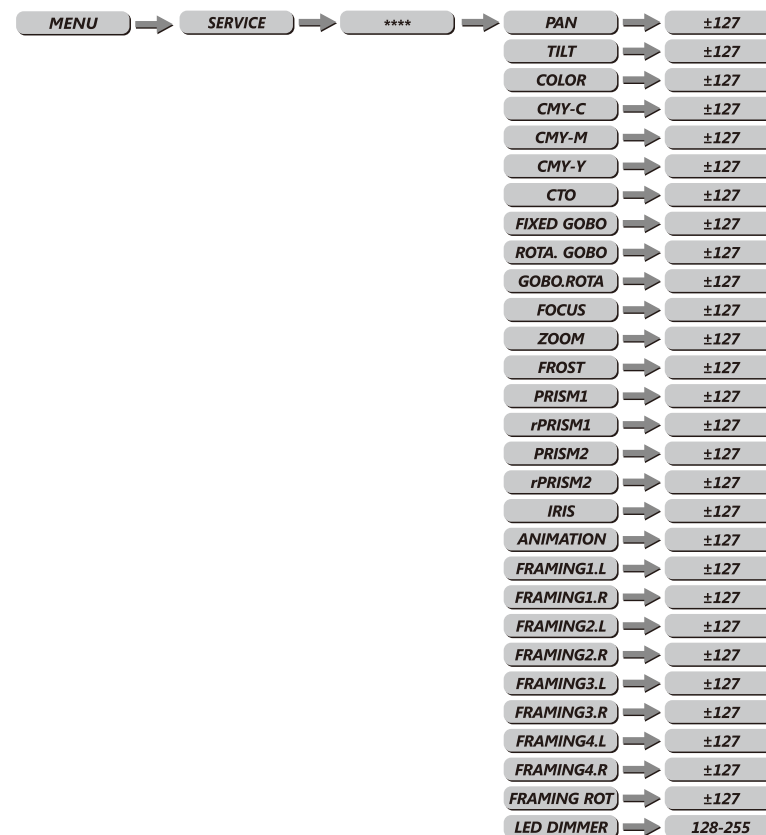
3.6 Performance



- enter option into the machine set.
- **PAN INVERT** : select normal for normal direction,select invert for inverted of the pan direction.
- **TILT INVERT** : select normal for normal direction,select invert for inverted of the tilt direction.
- **FANS** :
STUDIO: Noise control within 45dB, limiting power.
POWER: Noise control within 45dB, power reduction.
LIVE: Intelligent adjustment of wind speed, noise control within 55dB, power reduction, default to this mode.
- **BLACKOUT** : select OFF for immediate activation of PAN/TILT blackout when selected using the control channel or ON for 3 second delay before activation.
- **DIMMER** : menu for selection of dim4/dim3/dim2/dim1/off special dimming Curves.
- **LED PWM** : is PWM refresh rate bottom, press up/down to choose <1200hz>、<2000hz>、<2400hz>、<6000hz>、<25000hz>;
Attention: the gray level of dimming will be reduced as the refresh rate increases.
- **DMX ERROR** : select save to maintain last command in case of DMX error or black for blackout.
- **DISPLAY ON** : choose off and on to close and open the display open & close mode in menu.
- **DISPLAY LOCK** : choose off and on to close and open the screen lock mode in menu
- **LOAD PARA** : to upload data, choose NO means do not upload data choose YES means upload data,
- **SETTING** : is a protect bottom,settings lock is the menu lock bottom, choose off means the menu lock bottom is off, choose ON means the menu lock bottom is on recovery is the recover to default value.Press enter to password setting, press correct password "UP+DOWN+UP+DOWN",and press enter;if password is correct, display will show "OK",
CLEAN EDIT1 : clean customer self-editing scene 1, press enter confirm.
CLEAN EDIT2 : clean customer self-editing scene 2, press enter confirm.
WDMX HIDE : hide wireless mode, WDMX reset and signal hide and the default is Wired mode only.
- **NETWORK** : network setting, press enter in, depending on the mode, you can hide unwanted features. for example net switch=off IP mode=default.
UNIVERS :is data bulk setting, output series 0~255
IP MODE : IP mode setting, default IP is default IP,
CUSTOM IP : is customer's IP. Custom IP edit is customer's IP setting.
- **PT ENCODER** : XY encoder switch, off is close, on is open.
- **FOCUS LIMIT**: Focus limit , off is close, on is open.
- **WDMX** : reset wireless resetting, use for patch wireless signal, yes is clear the Receiver's message, press again patch wireless signal, no do not clear the receiver's message.
- **SIGNAL** : is signal setting, only XLRDMX is wire only, XLRDMX first is wire first, only WDMX is wireless only,WDMX first is wireless first,WDMX to XLR DMX is wireless to wired.

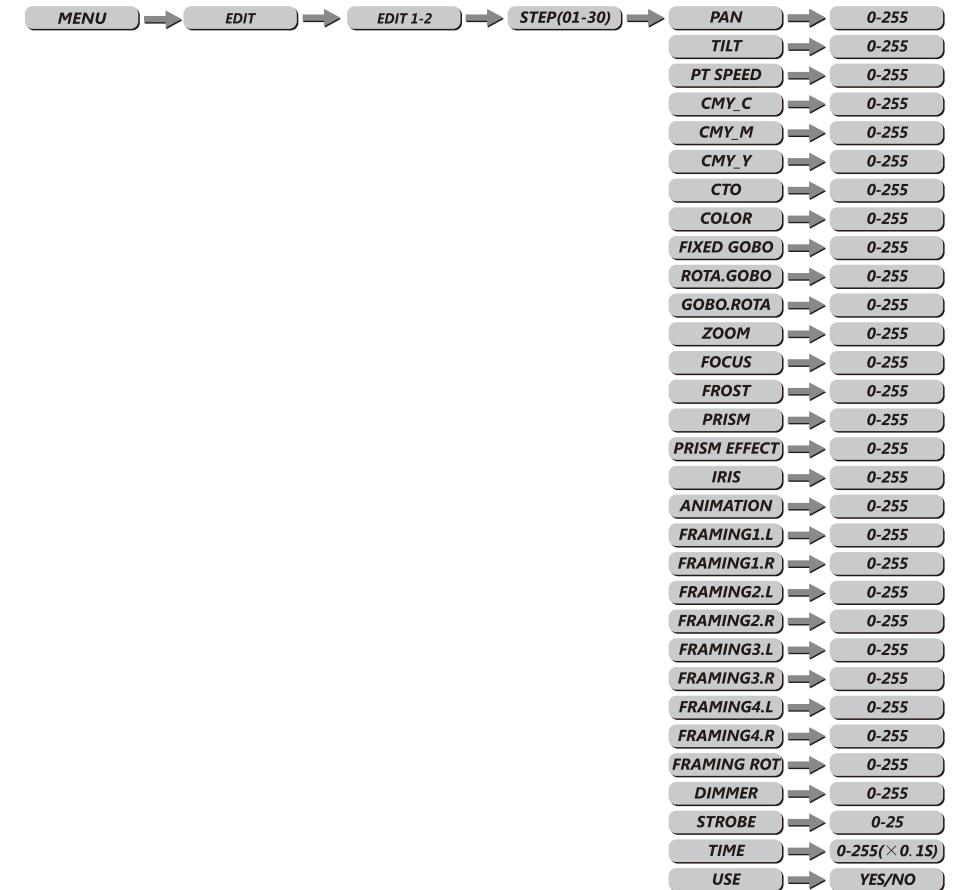

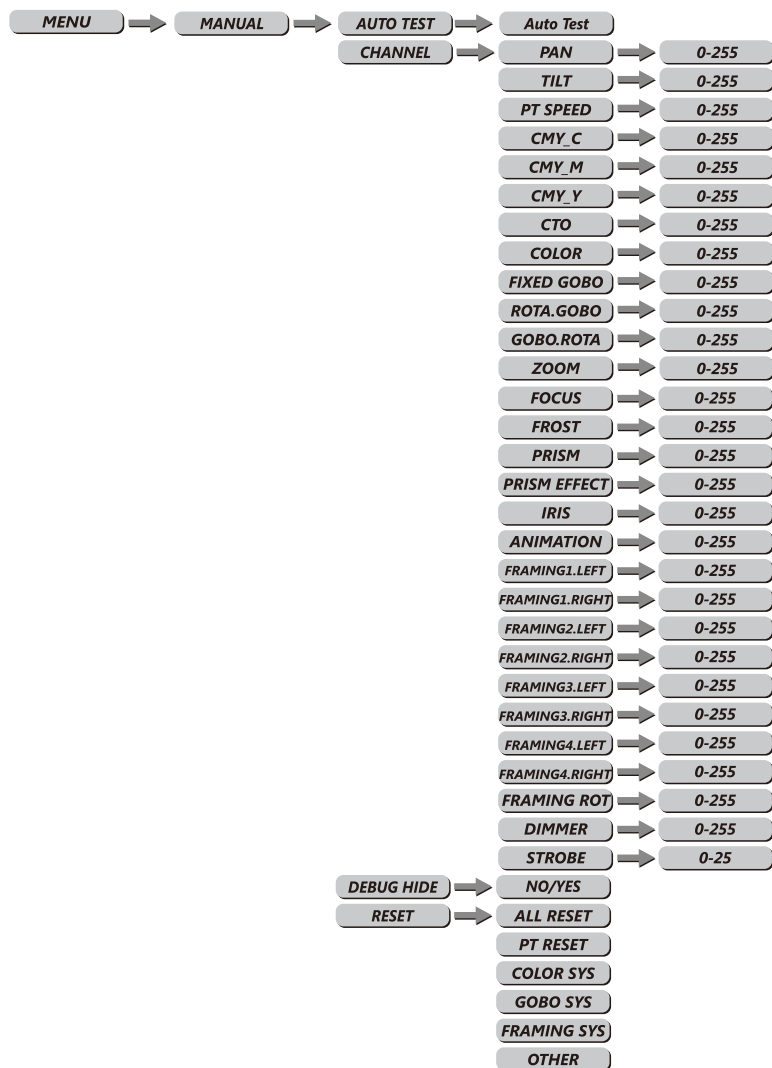

- **SYSTEM ERROR** : system information error Memory IC, AngleSensor, Pan Sensor, Pan Encoder, Pan Drive, Tilt Sensor, TiltEncoder, TiltDrive, Temperature, CMY_C Reset, CMY_M Reset, CMY_Y

3.7 EDIT



- Enter the Edit mode to edit the custom programs by adjusting the value of
- PAN,TILT,PT SPEED,CMY-C,CMY-M,CMY-Y,CTO,COLOR,FIXED GOBO, ROTA. GOBO,GOBO.ROTA,ZOOM,FOCUS,FROST,PRISM 1,PRISM 2,IRIS, ANIMATION, FRAMING1~4 LEFT&RIGHT,FRAMING ROT,DIMMER,STROBE,TIME .
- Enter Use and select Yes to run the steps user need.
- Note:if user want to circulate the created steps,please set the last step's TIME as 0.
- For example,there are 3 steps,the setting should be like belowed:
Step 1 TIME =4 Use =Yes
Step 2 TIME =5 Use =Yes
Step 3 TIME =0 Use =Yes

• Press enter into “AUTOTEST” at manual.

- **PAN** : pan set.
TILT : tilt set.
PT SPEED : set the pan & tilt speed.
CMY-C : CMY magenta.
CMY-M : CMY cyan .
CMY-Y : CMY yellow .
CTO : Color wheel set.
COLOR : Color temperature.
FIXED GOBO : set the static gobo wheel.
ROTA.GOBO : set the rotating gobo wheel.
GOBO.ROTA : set the autogiration of gobo wheel.
ZOOM : set the zoom of fixture.
FOCUS : set the focusing.
FROST : set the frost lens.
PRISM : set the prism .
PRISM EFFECT : set the prism effect.
IRIS : set the iris.
ANIMATION : set the ANIMATION,
FRAMING 1~4 Left & Right : set the FRAMING 1~4 Left&Right,push the UP/DOWN to set the value 000~255.
FRAMING ROT : set the framing rot,push the UP/DOWN to set the value 000~255.
DIMMER : set the dimmer.
STROBE : set the strobe, push the UP/DOWN to set the value 0~25.
- **DEBUG HIDE** : is the factory testing mode.All stepper motors are not controlled by signal,It only works again after the reset. enter No out,Enter Yes in.
- **RESET** : set the reset:
ALL RESET : select Yes/No to carry out all reset.
PT RESET : select Yes/No to carry out PAN/TILT reset.
COLOR SYSTEM : COLOR,CMY,CTO resetting, press No do not resetting, press Yes resetting.
GOBO SYSTEM : fixed gobo,rota.gobo,gobo.rota reset.
FRAMING SYSTEM : framing rot reset.
OTHER : focus,zoom,iris,frost,press No do not resetting, press Yes resetting.
